Conditions of Play & Attendance

****Attendance of the development camp (day 1) is a requirement of tournament entry.****

1. The Championship will be conducted under Australian Billiards and Snooker Council Championship Playing Conditions, and all matters pertaining to the Members' Protection Policy and the Players' Code of Conduct must be adhered to.
2. Entrants must be a financial member of an affiliated State/Territory Association of the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council and must be an Australian Citizen.
3. Entries will only be accepted on this official entry form and must include the entry fee. A completed entry form and entry fee will be required before any player is permitted to compete.
4. Format of the tournament is a ROUND ROBIN draw, the top 2 players from each group (at a minimum) will qualify for the knockout stage. The draw will be at the discretion of the organizing committee and no debate will be entered into. The length of round-robin matches will depend on entry numbers and available tables.
5. Championship Dress Code is required: Predominately plain coloured shirts with sleeves below the elbow, dark trousers or dark skirts, no shorter than kneecap must be worn for all matches, waistcoats to be worn for Knock-Out stages onwards. Dark coloured ladies' dress shoes shall be worn to all sessions and may be open or closed toe. No sports style shoes, sandals, or boots will be allowed. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the game. The Tournament Director may vary this dress code in extreme circumstances.
6. Travel allowances shall be reimbursed to players upon receipt of entry form, entry fee and completed claim form. The allowance is not redeemable for cash. In the event that the player withdraws from this event, the travel allowance must be returned in full to Snooker & Billiards NSW immediately. Full terms & conditions of travel allowances and schedule are included below.
7. All players are to be ready to play at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start of their match. Condition 6 of the Championship Playing Conditions applies to a player or players not ready to commence their match on time.
8. Seeding into knock-out stage from the round robin will be calculated in accordance with Condition 9 of the Championship Playing Conditions.
9. This entry form constitutes part of the conditions of entry. Changes may be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director
10. Players may be subjected to drug testing in accordance with the ABSC Drugs in Sport Policy.
11. INDEMNITY: All participants enter this competition at their own risk. None of the ABSC, SBNSW, Wests Illawarra Leagues Club, sponsors, or organisers shall be liable for any loss, injury or misadventure however arising.
12. A player who gives a walkover in a knock-out match, without prior approval of exceptional circumstances by the Tournament Director, will forfeit their right to any prize monies.
