Tournament Conditions (read carefully before entering):

- **Eligibility:** As this event is a State Championship all entrants are required to:
 - (i) comply with NSW residency criteria; i.e. must be a NSW resident and have been permanently domiciled in the State of NSW for a minimum period of six (6) months immediately prior to this event;
 - (ii) not have previously competed in another State Championship of the same discipline (i.e. snooker) in the same calendar year.
- Tournament will be conducted under the Rules of Play & Code of Ethics as contained in the Australian Billiards & Snooker Council Handbook (and amendments). Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action by BSA NSW.
- Seedings will apply based on the National Snooker Rankings as per the ABSC website.
- Tailored trousers, dark socks & dress shoes, Snooker NSW polo or plain black or white polo
- Or long sleeve plain coloured shirt. **Full Dress on Sunday**
- Players to mark their own games until referees can be supplied
- Locally based players within a 40km radius may be required on Friday night
- Games will be best of five (5), then best of seven (7) depending on entry numbers.
