TOURNAMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

- As this event is a State Championship all entrants are required to:
 - (i) *comply with NSW residency criteria; i.e. must be a NSW resident and have been permanently domiciled in the State of NSW for a minimum period of six (6) months immediately prior to this event;
 - (ii) not have previously competed in another State's Championship of the same discipline (i.e. snooker) in the same calendar year;
 - (iii) Entrants must have a date of birth on or before 01/01/1984
- The Championship will be played subject to the Rules of Snooker as prescribed by WPBSA.
- ABSC Playing Conditions and all matters pertaining to Player's Code of Conduct and Ethics will also be adhered to. Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action being taken against the offenders.
- NOTE: No players or referees are permitted to smoke or consume alcohol whilst involved in playing or refereeing a game – unless during an official session break.
- Dress Code: Tailored trousers, SBNSW Official State Polo shirt or a plain Black or White polo, or long sleeve predominately plain coloured shirt, dark colour dress shoes & socks for Friday & Saturday.
- Tournament standard dress is required on Sunday: Tailored trousers, long sleeve predominately plain coloured shirt buttoned at the wrist, Bow Tie, Waist Coat, dark socks & dress shoes must be worn for all matches.
- Failure to comply with any of these conditions will result in forfeiture of the game.
- Entries (limited to 71) & memberships only accepted online. Players must be contactable from details listed in entry or application and not through a second party, otherwise entry may be null and void.
- Players will receive an email with playing conditions and draw a few days prior.
- Format: straight knock-out, *top 32 seeded. All preliminary games will be best of five (5) frames; Final best of seven (7) frames. Prize money subject to entries and sponsorship.
- Players to mark their own games, a room referee will be available. Referees will be provided from the last 16 onwards, subject to availability.
- Tournament director may vary conditions and decision will be final. **
- No entry will be accepted without being a financial member of SBNSW
- Players within a 40 km radius must be available Friday night if required.
- No playing time requests will be accepted.

DRESS REGULATIONS



POLO SHIRT

SBNSW Official State Polo shirt
OR
plain black or white polo

POLO SHIRT

No coloured or patterned polos
No other unapproved logos or graphics - including club shirts



DRESS SHIRT

Long sleeve predominately plain coloured dress shirt/blouse with full buttoning down the front & collar suitable for the wearing of a necktie or bow tie.

DRESS SHIRT

Shirts/blouses must be tucked into trousers and long enough to ensure this is the case throughout the entire duration of the match. Shirts/blouses must be clean and ironed.



TROUSERS

Full length traditional tailored dress trousers - intended to be worn with a suit.
Dark, predominately plain coloured.

TROUSERS

No jeans, cargo pants, or other casual pants
Trousers with cuts or rips are not permitted.
No trousers with stitched-on, jeans like, pockets and no metal button closure.



FOOTWEAR

Formal shoes of a style that is befitting whilst wearing a suit.
Loafers and men's dress boots are permitted but must have a traditional heel profile.
Socks must be in-keeping with the style of suit in terms of length and colour

FOOTWEAR

Sport shoes, high boots and shoes with a complete flat sole are not acceptable.
No dirty or broken/torn shoes.
White athletic socks are not permitted.
