TOURNAMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility: Players who have won any WWS, IBSF, APSBF, Oceania, Australian (exceptions apply), NSW or other State Women's Snooker Championship are ineligible. Past winners of this particular Championship are ineligible as are past winners of similar inter-state 'minor' Women's Snooker Championships;
2. As this event is a State Championship all entrants are required to:
 - comply with NSW residency criteria; i.e. must be a NSW resident and have been permanently domiciled in the State of NSW for a minimum period of six (6) months immediately prior to this event;
 - not have previously competed in another State's Championship of the same discipline in the same calendar year;
3. The Championship will be played subject to the Rules of Snooker as prescribed by the WPBSA.
4. ABSC Playing Conditions and all matters pertaining to Player's Code of Conduct and Ethics will also be adhered to. Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action being taken against the offenders.
5. NOTE: No players or referees are permitted to smoke or consume alcohol whilst involved in playing or refereeing a game – unless during an official session break.
6. Tournament standard dress is required:
 - **SATURDAY ONLY:** SBNSW Polo shirt or plain black or white polo shirt OR Plain coloured collared dress shirt with sleeves below the elbows;
 - **SUNDAY:** Plain coloured collared shirt with sleeves below the elbows (NO POLOS)
 - Dark coloured tailored trousers or dark skirt, no shorter than kneecap, ladies dark coloured dress shoes (open or closed toe) shall be worn to all sessions. Waistcoat is optional for the knock-out stage. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in forfeiture of the game.
7. Format & prize money will be determined subject to number of entries received.
8. Entries & memberships only accepted online & will be required before any player is permitted to compete. Players must be contactable from details listed in entry or application and not through a second party, otherwise entry may be nullified.
9. Players to mark their own games, a room referee will be available. Referees will be provided from the Semi Finals onwards, subject to availability.
