

TOURNAMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

Eligibility: The following eligibility criteria will apply:

- You must be a current (2023/24 financial year) financial member of SBNSW.
- You must be a NSW resident and have been permanently domiciled in NSW for a minimum period of six (6) months immediately prior to this event;
- You must not have previously competed in another State's Championship of the same discipline (i.e. Billiards) in the same calendar year.

Rules: The Championship will be played subject to Rules of Billiards prescribed by the WPBSA. Any discrepancies will be referred to the Tournament Director for adjudication.

Playing Conditions: ABSC Playing Conditions and the Player's Code of Conduct and Ethics. Any breach or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action.

Smoking and Alcohol: No players or referees are permitted to smoke/vape or consume alcohol whilst involved in playing or refereeing a game – unless during an official session break.

Dress: Players are required to wear the polo shirt provided by the sponsor - to be supplied on the day. (Polos can be retained by the player following the event) Tailored trousers; socks; dark dress shoes. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of match.

Refereeing: All players will be required to referee matches as directed by the Tournament Director. Losing players in knockout rounds will be expected to referee the following matches, and if not required they must seek leave from the tournament director before leaving the venue.

Completion of matches: As part of the entry conditions, all players must complete all their matches, regardless of their current form or where they may finish in their group.

Format & Prizemoney: Round Robin – Points target to be determined and will be part-based on the number of entries received. The NSW Billiards Rankings will be applied to determine seeding for the event. Format subject to change depending on the number of entries. Guaranteed prize pool of \$3000, paid down to the last 16, including a \$100 encouragement award for the best performing newcomer.

Entries & memberships are only accepted online & will be required before any player is permitted to compete. No entry will be accepted without being a financial member of SBNSW.
